Addressing the event in Ahmedabad, Abe said that India - Japan partnership was special, strategic and global.

Sushma Swaraj speech at U.N. General Assembly



Sept.23, External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj, addressed the 72nd session of United Nations General Assembly Session in New York. She lambasted Pakistan Prime Minister Shahid Khaqan Abbasi for claiming that human rights violations in areas of Jammu and Kashmir. Swaraj further said, "We are completely engaged in fighting poverty, but our neighbour Pakistan seems only engaged in fighting us. She ended her speech by reciting a verse that is a synthesis of thought:

May all be happy;
May all be healthy;
May all see what is good;
May all be free from suffering.

GST collection for August slips to Rs 90,669 crore



The government has collected Rs 90,669 crore in Goods and Services Tax for August, the second month of the indirect tax regime rollout. According to the revised estimate, the GST mop-up for July stood at Rs 94,063 crore, up from the initial projection of Rs 92,283 crore. "The total revenue of GST paid under different heads (up to September 25, 2017) is Rs 90,669 crore," an official statement said, adding these figures do not include GST paid by 10.24 lakh assesses who have opted for composition scheme.

Of this, as much as Rs 14,402 crore has come in from the Central GST (CGST), Rs 21,067 crore from State GST (SGST), Rs 47,377 crore from Integrated GST (IGST) and Rs 7,823 crore from compensation cess levied on demerit and luxury goods.

SBI cuts minimum average balance from 5,000 to Rs 3,000



Sept.25, SBI has lowered the average minimum balance requirement under its savings account for metro customers to Rs 3,000 from Rs 5,000 earlier following protests. The bank has also decided to do away with the minimum balance requirement for minors and pensioners and has reduced the penal charges.

In a statement issued here on Monday, SBI said that the bank has decided to treat metro and urban centres in the same category.

PV Sindhu wins Korea Open Super Series title



Sept.17, PV Sindhu became the first Indian badminton player to lift the title in Korea after she beat Nozomi Okuhara in the women's singles final at Korea Open Superseries in Seoul on Sunday. This was her third Super Series title and second this year. In a rematch of the World Championships final which was won by Okuhara, Sindhu avenged her loss from Glasgow and won the Korea Open Superseries final 22-20 11-21 21-18 and claimed the title.

Indians add 2 gold, 1 silver in Asian Indoor Games

Sept.19, India's impressive show in the 5th Asian Indoor and Martial Arts Games continued as their athletes added two gold and one bronze on the fourth day of competitions, in Ashgabat.

Govindan Lakshmanan and PU Chitra clinched a gold each in men's 5000m and women's 1500m races while Dharmender won the bronze in men's freestyle 70kg belt wrestling as India's medal count swelled to 3 gold, 2 silver and 2 bronze.

Hardik Pandya, Ajinkya Rahane and Rohit Sharma all struck half-centuries to guide India to a five-wicket win to clinch the five-match ODI series.

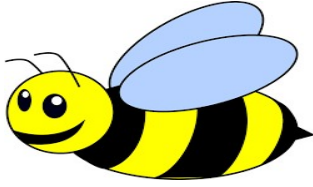

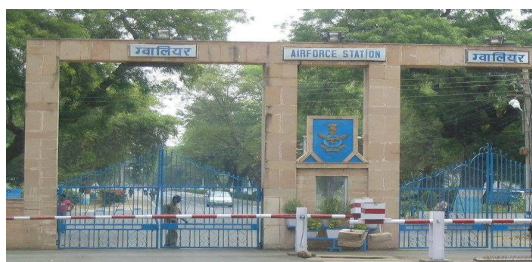

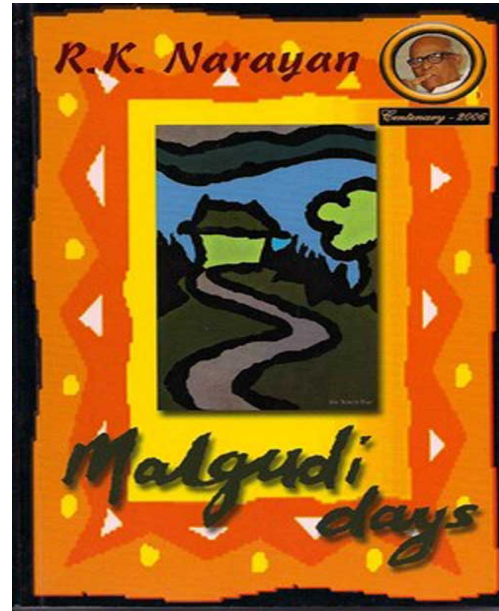
