New Delhi: Ruling parties on Aug 28th won the assembly by polls with the BJP retaining both seats in Goa while AAP retained the Bawana seat in Delhi by defeating the BJP by a huge margin and the TDP snatching the Nandyal seat from YSR Congress in Andhra Pradesh. In Goa, Chief Minister Manohar P arrikar won from Panaji while Health Minister Vishwajit Rane won the Valpoi seat .

'CHARAN VANDANA' ON SENIOR CITIZEN DAY




